The 54th meeting of the Delhi Khadi Village & Industries Board was held on 24.10.2025 at 10.30 AM at Nigam Bhawan, 5th Floor, Kashmere Gate, Delhi – 110006 under the Chairmanship of Sardar Manjinder Singh Sirsa, Hon'ble Minister of Industries, Govt. of NCT of Delhi and Chairman, DKVIB.

4. MD, DKVIB welcomed the Hon'ble Chairman, DKVIB and Members of the Board including Experts.
